

PRIVACY NOTICE – NEWSLETTER

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

in accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – “**GDPR**”), we hereby provide you with information relating to the processing of your e-mail address, which you have filled in the subscription field of our newsletter on the website <https://www.bristell.com> or provided to us for the same purpose in another way (“**Personal Data**”).

1. Controller

- 1.1 The controller of your personal data shall be **BRM AERO, s.r.o.**, company ID No.: 291 90 924, registered office Letecká č.ev. 255, 686 04 Kunovice, Czech Republic, registered in the Commercial Register kept at the Regional Court in Brno under file No. C 64441 (“**Controller**”).
- 1.2 The Controller may be contacted in the following ways:

- 1.3 The Controller has not appointed a data protection officer.

2. Purposes of the processing and legal basis for the processing

- 2.1 The purpose of the processing of Personal Data is the direct marketing of the Controller consisting in sending the Controller's newsletter (commercial communications). The legal basis for the processing of Personal Data is the consent given by you pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR. This consent shall also be deemed to be consent to the sending of commercial communications pursuant to Section 7(2) of Act No. 480/2004 Coll., on Certain Information Society Services and on Amendments to Certain Acts, as amended.

3. Recipients and storage period

- 3.1 Personal Data will be processed by the Controller primarily by its own employees or agents or shared with the Controller's processors.
- 3.2 The Controller will never transfer Personal Data to countries outside the European Union or the European Economic Area or to international organisations.
- 3.3 For the above purpose, the Controller will keep the Personal Data until your consent to processing is withdrawn.

4. Your rights

- 4.1 You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of Personal Data at any time. Withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing of Personal Data based on this consent prior to its withdrawal. After your consent is withdrawn, the Controller must continue to process the Personal Data, however, the purpose of this processing will be solely to ensure that the Personal Data is not used for the purpose set out above. The legal basis for this processing of Personal Data will be to comply with a legal obligation under Article 6(1)(c) GDPR.
- 4.2 You also have the right to request access to Personal Data from the Controller, i.e. the right to obtain confirmation from the Controller as to whether or not Personal Data is being processed and, if so, the right to access Personal Data and other specified information. You also have the right to have inaccurate Personal Data corrected or incomplete Personal Data completed.
- 4.3 If any of the grounds listed in Article 17(1) GDPR are applied and none of the conditions listed in Article 17(3) GDPR are met, you have the right to have your Personal Data erased.

- 4.4 If the case referred to in Article 18(1) GDPR occurs, you have the right to restrict the processing of Personal Data.
- 4.5 If the Controller processes Personal Data by automated means, you have the right to obtain Personal Data from the Controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, where technically feasible, you have the right to request that the Controller transfer the Personal Data to another entity.
- 4.6 You may exercise all of the rights set out herein by contacting the Controller as set out in clause 1.2 of this document.
- 4.7 If you believe that the processing of Personal Data has infringed the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the country of your habitual residence, place of your work or place of the alleged infringement. This supervisory authority for the Czech Republic is the Office for Personal Data Protection, located at Pplk.
